Sri Aloke Kumar Nandy, Executive Engineer, PWD (Roads), DTRD, cum member secretary revised the agendas of the meeting and Chairman initiated the discussion by following up on the resolutions undertaken in the previous DRSC meeting held on 11-01-2023. 1	Police Department	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Inclusion of all Officer-in-charges of Police Stations in the DRSC committee and also in DRSC WhatsApp group. Police Deptt. should instruct the OCs to share everyday accident data base with geotagged location and the type & reason of the accident in the DRSC WhatsApp group. The OCs are also to report whether 108 ambulances provided services in the noted accident.
2	D.T.O.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Strict monitoring of the Driving License Test.
3	PWD (NH) / PWD (Roads) / Police Deptt.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Site visit of the team on the vulnerable accident spots based on the data of Police Deptt. where accidents occurred in the last calendar year 2022 and in the month of January/February 2023 and the engineers of PWD Roads and PWD NH along with Officer-in-charges of concerned Police Station are to suggest the preventive road safety measures to be adopted in each of these spots. The identification and survey of these spots to be completed within 7 days and the data to be presented in the next DRSC meeting.
4	Inspector of Schools, Education Deptt.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Issue letter to all the principals of school and colleges to create awareness programme on road safety and also check student's license, wearing of helmet and registration certificates of the vehicles brought to the institutes.
5	Health Deptt.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share the contact numbers of all 108 ambulance drivers to the Officer-in-charge of police stations under Hailakandi district. Also JDHS to provide the list in the DRSC WhatsApp group. The District incharge of 108 ambulances to be included in the DRSC committee and to attend all the following DRSC meetings. JDHS to present data about the response time of 108 ambulances who were engaged in rescuing victims of accidents occurred from 11th Jan' 23 to 27th Feb' 23. The said data base to be presented in excel format in the next DRSC meeting. Also JDHS to present the roster sheet of emergency ward attendants in hospitals, and the condition/facilities of the emergency ward.
6.	Member Secretary, DRSC	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Invite all the Circle Officers of Hailakandi in the next DRSC meeting.
