

Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) Meeting for the month of March, 2022 held on 02-03-2022 at 11.00 A.M. in the Conference Hall of DC's Office, Hailakandi.

The meeting was presided over by District Development Commissioner, Hailakandi. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting. The SDO (S), Hailakandi requested all concerned for timely submission of report under ADP for uploading monthly KPI data on time. 


