

Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) Meeting for the month of December, 2022 held on 07-12-2022 at 11.00 A.M. in the Mini Conference Hall of DC's Office, Hailakandi.

Members Present: As per Annexure -'A'.

The meeting was presided over by the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress/ achievement of development schemes department wise and following decisions were taken:

1. HEALTH:

- Regarding identification of land for construction of Health Sub-center at Bagcherra Forest village, DFO informed that land for the purpose has been identified.
- On query from Deputy Commissioner regarding non availability of water supply provision in all the Health Institutions, the representative of Joint Director of Health Services present in the meeting informed that list of 28 nos. of Health Institutions has been submitted to the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Hailakandi. The Deputy Commissioner directed the CEO, Zilla Parishad, Hailakandi and BDO's to take measures for water supply provision in all these institutions functional under MGNREGS or any other fund.

(Action: CEO, Zilla Parishad, BDO's and Jt. Director, Health Services, Hailakandi)

2. PWD (Building):

- The EE informed that piling work of Judicial Officer's Quarter completed. Further, he stated that termination notice issued to the contractor and re-allotment process initiated.
- Regarding Kalinagar PHC, the EE informed that work of painting is going on and will be completed within a month.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed ADC (Magistracy) regarding Bilaipur MPHC which is occupied by police personnel for taking necessary steps for vacating the premises.
- The EE informed that progress of Model Women College at Aynekhal is 35%. The Deputy Commissioner directed EE to complete the work within the stipulated time of completion.
- As regards, construction of DTO office and DSA ground the Deputy Commissioner will visit the work site of both the schemes.
- The EE informed that land development work and construction boundary wall of District Science centre is going on.
- Regarding Multipurpose Building Sevakunja under Untied fund, the EE, PWD (B) was directed to expedite the work and submit UC of the released amount at the earliest.
- As regards, Model Residential School at Bondukmara the EE informed that, 37% of work has been completed so far.

3. PWD (Roads):

- The EE, PWD (Roads) informed that schemes under PMGSY and RIDF are in progress and expected to be completed within the stipulated time.

- The EE, PWD (Roads) informed that under CM's Special Package there is a land problem on the right bank of North Narainpur bridge approach. The Deputy Commissioner requested to take up the matter with concerned Circle Officer for resolving the issue.
- The EE, PWD (Roads) informed that SOPD (G) works will be completed within Dec., 2022.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the EE, PWD (Roads) to come on 09-12-2022 at 3.30 P.M. alongwith all AEE/ Field Officers and contractors for review of schemes.

4. PHE:

- The EE PHE informed that against the target of 63107 nos. of FHTC for the year 2022-23, 9266 nos. has been completed so far.
- The, EE, PHE informed that, regarding drinking water supply in schools : Total no. of Rural schools is 1327 nos. Achievement is 1298nos. Work for remaining 29 nos. will be complete soon.
- The, EE, PHE informed that, regarding drinking water supply in AWCs : Total no. of AWCs is 150 nos. Achievement is 144nos. Work for remaining 06 nos. will be complete soon.
- The EE, PHE to give information DFO, Hailakandi regarding any scheme of PHE Deptt proposed to be executed in the forest area for better coordination.

5. AGRICULTURE:

- The DAO informed that, under PM KISAN, total 72,397. nos. of beneficiary are getting payment at present. Total Aadhar authenticated is 50,682 nos but e-KYC done so far is 43,335nos. So the gap of 7343 nos should be complete at the earliest.
- DAO to hold meeting for paddy procurement. Also to submit list of godowns to the Deputy Commissioner.
- The Deputy Commissioner advised the DAO to complete crop cutting within specified time.
- DAO to take steps for increase in no. of FPO/FPCs.

6. A.H&VETY:

- On a query from the Chair the Dist. Veterinary Officer informed, the house that there are 13 nos. of Artificial Insemination (AI) centres in the district.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the Dist. Veterinary Officer to hold meetings all BDO along with GP Secretaries for ensuring vaccination & tagging of cattle before sale out in the cattle market.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the DVO to organize awareness campaigns throughout the district

(Action: All BDOs, Dist. Vety. Officer, Hailakandi)

8. NULM and ASRLM:

- On a query from the Deputy Commissioner the DPM, ASRLM informed that, there is no issue related to the respective departments at present.

8. Municipal Board,

- DC directed E.O Hailakandi to convey a separate meeting to review all schemes under Hailakandi & Lala Municipal Boards on 8/12/2022

(Action: E.O. HMB, E.O. Lala,)

9. Water Resources:

- On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, the EE water Resource department informed that, works of the schemes under SOPD, FDR, CM's Spl. Package, NABARD, SDRF are in progress and expected to be completed by 31st Dec/2022.
- The EE also informed the house that proposals for embankment at Matijuri and Mohanpur under FDR have been sent to the DDMA. IN this regard the DC requested ADC (DDMA) to look in to the matter.
- EE, PWD (NH) Silchar Division raised the issue of damage of portion of NH at sinking zone near Panchgram, to which the DC advised for joint visit of W/R and PWD (NH) departments so identify the reason behind it.

(Action: ADC(DDMA), EE, Water Resources, Hailakandi & EE PWD (NH) Silchar)

10. Irrigation:

- The EE informed that out of 270 nos of STW, 69 nos (Solar) and 123nos. (electrical) no. of points are functional. There no such issue at present.

11. PWD (NH) :

- On a query from the Deputy Commissioner regarding damaged portion of the NH near Bakrihwar the EE, PWD (NH) informed that, work has been started in the damaged portion.

(Action: EE, PWD (NH), Hailakandi)

12. Fishery:

- The DFDO, Hailakandi informed that, all new schemes are going on. There is no issue at present.

(Action: DFDO, Hailakandi)

13. DI&CC:

- The GM, D I & CC informed that, awareness campaign under PMFME is going on.
- In this connection, the Deputy Commissioner directed the GM, DI&CC to hold meeting with DPM, ASRLM and Dist Agriculture Officer regarding implementation of the programme.

15. Transport:

- As per monthly report total revenue collected upto 31st Oct/2022 is Rs.68015316.00.
- The DTO to initiate regular drives for checking of helmets in Town areas of the district.

16. Excise:

- The Deputy Commissioner directed the Supdt. Excise to conduct raid on illegal selling of liquors .He also directed the Supdt. to take steps for increase in revenue collection.

17. Women & Child Development

- The DSWO informed that, out of total 1341 no. of AWCs, 163 nos. of AWCs are to be rationalized. The Deputy Commissioner advised the DSWO to pay special attention for rationalization in respect of Lala ICDS project.
- The Deputy Commissioner expressed satisfaction over increase in the no. of SAM, MAM child detection and requested DSWO to take steps for their treatment.

➤ The Deputy Commissioner directed the DSWO to prepare proposal for AWC in Hailakandi/ Lala town area.

➤ Further DSWO was directed to pay special attention to PMMVY.

➤ The CEO Zilla Parishad informed that, under Amrit Sarovar scheme, total no. of locations identified is 61. Out of which 28 nos (old list), 33 nos (new list). Identification of remaining 14 nos. is under progress to achieve district target of 75 nos. and DPR approved for 20 nos.
