Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) meeting for the month of March, 2023 held on 09-03-2023 at 11.00 A.M. in the Conference Hall of O/o the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi.

Members Present: As per Annexure –‘A’.

The meeting was presided over by the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the Deputy Commissioner reviewed the progress/ achievement of development schemes department wise and following decisions were taken:

1. Water Resources:

- The EE, Water Resource informed the house the progress of different ongoing schemes under SOPD/FDR/CM's Spl. Package/NABARD. 3 no. of schemes under these projects will be completed within March/2023 and the schemes Const. of sluice culvert & guide bundh over Chirunala to protect Dholai Molai pt-V has just started.
- Regarding the scheme Anti erosion measures at Uttar Narayanpur-Pt-III,IV, and Singlarpar, Kalinagar Pt-IV- from the erosion of river Katakhal on its L/B, the EE informed that shifting of 100 meters of alignment work is required. The Deputy Commissioner directed to solve the issue with LA branch.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed to constitute a Task Force under the chairmanship of Addl. Deputy Commissioner alongwith EE, Water Resource, EE, PHE and AGM, APDCL to solve out the problem of shifting the electrical line of the schemes 1. Restoration of Dyke on L/B of river Katakhal from Borotoi to confluence including breach closing works and 2. Restoration of Dyke "Flood protection and drainage of Bakrihawar area under Hailakandi civil Sub Division on the left bank of river Barak including Breach closing works and also shifting of water pipe line from the middle of the embankment at Bakrihawar within ten days .

(Action: ADC, EE, Water Resources, EE, PHE, Hailakandi and AGM, APDCL, Hailakandi)

2.PHE:

- The EE, PHE informed that against the target of 63107 nos. of FHTC for the year 2022-23, 14525 nos. has been completed so far.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed EE, PHE to submit Action plan for providing water supply to balance 27 nos of schools and 6 nos AWC from nearby schemes immediately.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed EE, PHE for hydro testing of 4 nos ESR, i.e Bhatirkupa, Boalipar, Chiparsangam and Chandipur II to be completed by Monday (13/3/2023) and balance distribution network at these GPs to be provided at the earliest under Greater Algapur Hailakandi MVS.
- All the engagement letters of Jal Mitra should be distributed in respect of completed schemes and ensure that the gap should be nil.

(Action : EE, PHE, Hailakandi)

3. PWD (Roads) :

- Regarding land acquisition for bridge approach in respect of the scheme Constn. of RCC bridge at North Narayanpur ferryghat over river Katakhal under CM's Spl. Package for Barak Valley 2013-14, the Deputy Commissioner asked the Dist Development Commissioner to visit the site alongwith EE, PWD (Roads) on 10th March, 2023 to resolve the issue and submit report in this regard.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the EE, PWD (Roads) to expedite works Assam- Mizoram border roads and completed within the stipulated time.
- The DFO informed the house that deduction of forest royalty in regards to works deptt. is less than the norms and requested for deduction of the same as per 34d schedule. In this regard, the Deputy Commissioner directed the EEs of works deptt. to take up the matter with their respective authority for clarification.

4. PWD (Building):

- The EE PWD HDTB informed that progress of work of DTO office is slow due to non receipt of payment. The Deputy Commissioner directed DTO to communicate with Govt. for fund.
- Regarding Bilaiपुर MPHC, the EE PWD HDTB requested for removal of seized materials and truck for completion of remaining works. The Deputy Commissioner directed Smti. S. Endow, ACS, ADC to coordinate the same and submit report.

(Action:- Smti. S. Endow, ACS, ADC and EE, PWD (Bldg), HDTB, Hailakandi)

5. HEALTH:

- The Joint Director of Health Services, informed the house that, Sastha Sabha Utsav will start from 6th April, 2023 to 10th April, 2023 for which external evaluator from Medical and Officers from line deptt. have been identified and in this regard a orientation programme held on 0th March, 2023 in the Conference Hall of Deputy Commissioner's office, Hailakandi..

6. Transport:

- As per monthly report total revenue collected so far is Rs.110832444.00.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the DTO to take steps for achieving the target.
- The EE, PWD (Roads) raised the issue of traffic restriction on Matijuri bridge. In this regard, the Deputy Commissioner directed EE to communicate the same to DTO formally to look into the matter.

7.AGRICULTURE:

- The DAO informed that, under PM KISAN, total 73,197. nos. of beneficiary are getting payment at present. Total Aadhar authenticated is 51,481 nos. but e-KYC done so far is 46,093 nos.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed DAO to submit Circle wise pendency report of PM KISAN to DDC, Hailakandi.
- The DAO informed that, out of 4000MT, 906 MT paddy has been procured till date. In this regard no. of farmers registered 320 nos. and certificate issued 295 nos.
- On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, DAO informed that the construction of ADO's office at Lala stopped due to injunction by court. The Deputy Commissioner directed to expedite the works of the remaining ADO's office and complete early.

- The GM, DI&CC informed that under PMEGP, 2022-23, 392 nos applications received. Proposals sponsored to Bank 336 nos. and proposals sanctioned by Bank -89 nos., rejected 183 nos. and pending 72 nos.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed GM, DI&CC to take the matter with LDM and verify the reasons for rejection and also the cases pending with banks.

- **Lala:** As per monthly report of Lala MB, out of total 1154 no. of beneficiaries under PMAY (Urban), 1005 nos. are completed.
- **Hailakandi:** As per monthly report of Hailakandi MB, out of total 2651 no. of beneficiaries under PMAY (Urban), 1585 nos. are completed.

- The Deputy Commissioner directed CDPOs to mobilize the SAM children and increase the SAM referral activity and SAM admission to the NRC as per the criteria i.e. without Medical issues SAM Children.
- In respect of const./ renovation of AWCs, the list to be submitted with issues reflecting in the remarks column to the DDC, Hailakandi for the onward submission to the P&RD Dept.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed DSWO to take up the matter with APDCL regarding meter checking and resolve the issue of bill.

11. Fishery:

- On a query from the Deputy Commissioner, the DFDO informed that the total fish production in the district is 16000.93 MT. The Deputy Commissioner directed to increase the fish production.

- The Supdt. of Excise informed the house that, 42 nos of drives on illegal liquor conducted during the month.
- The Deputy Commissioner directed the Supdt. to take steps for increase in revenue collection.

13. TAX:

- The Supdt. taxes, Hailakandi informed the house regarding Revenue collection for the month of January/2023.

- The Deputy Commissioner also directed EE to prepare PPT for the next DDC meeting onwards incorporating items like Total Commnad area, Total irrigated land Lift Irrigation projects etc. and find out areas where there is scope for check dam.

15. ASRLM :

- The DPM, ASRLM informed that the house that due to multiple task to be done simultaneously on field like, Mission Antyodaya Survey for all GPs, Survey & verification of all beneficiaries of PMAY-G, NSAP, Job Card Holder of MGNREGA through SANYOG App, Generation of Ayushman Card through e-KYC verification, verification of FHTC under JJM and all activities related to ASRLM, the Community Cadres of ASRLM are overloaded and progress of all parameters are being hampered.

16. PWD (NH):

- The Official present in the meeting informed regarding construction of bridge on Dhaleswari by-pass that after inspection of dimensions by RDSO, execution of slab casting will be done and after curing period the Dholeswar Bypass will be opened to vehicular traffic.

17. Handloom and Textiles:

- The Asstt. Director, Handloom and Textiles requested all the district Heads of Deptt. to purchase Gamcha from hs office for official functions.

18. Education

- The DEEO informed that, the pupils attendance is less than 50% against 2 nos. of schools in Hailakandi and Lala and 1 no. of school in Katlicherra. Further, DEEO informed that pupils attendance is less than 60% in 2 nos. of school in Katlicherra.
- The DEEO informed that a total of 68 nos. of schools were visited by IS, Hailakandi and BEEO, Hailakandi, Lala and Katlicherra during the month of February, 2023.
- The DEEO informed that out of 23 nos. of schools without electricity, 11 nos. of schools have already been electrified and remaining 12 nos. yet to electrified. In this regard, the Deputy Commissioner directed DEEO to pursue the matter with AGM, APDCL for completion remaining schools.
- The DC directed the DEEO and BEEO's to visit schools and check the MDM (PM-POSHAN) on priority basis and also to take strict action against Head Teacher if any anomalies are found.

- The DEEO informed that out of 43 nos. of non-functional girls' toilet, 19 nos. are made functional. Further, the DEEO informed that out of 56 nos. of non-functional boy's toilet, 18 nos are made functional. In this regard, the Deputy Commissioner directed DEEO to take steps for making functional the remaining toilets.
- The DEEO informed that out of 83 nos. of school having no drinking water facility, 22 nos has been made functional from infrastructure grant and remaining 61 no list handed over to PHE for drinking water arrangement by tapping lines from nearby WSS schemes.

19.Assam Khadi & Vill. Industries:

- The D.O. informed that, out of 19 nos. applications sponsored to Banks out of which 12 nos. have been sanctioned by Bank.

At the end, the Deputy Commissioner directed all Heads of Deptt. to submit report in the light of last DDC meeting minutes.
