Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) meeting for the month of May, 2023 held on 04-05-2023 at 10.30 A.M. in the Conference Hall of O/o the Deputy Commissioner, Hailakandi.

Members Present: As per Annexure –‘A’.

The meeting was presided over by the District Development Commissioner, Hailakandi. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the District Development Commissioner reviewed the progress/ achievement of development schemes department wise and following decisions were taken:

1. Water Resources:

- The EE, Water Resources informed that the scheme “Restoration of dyke on L/B of river Katakhal from Boraitali to Confluence including breach closing work” consists of 3 Nos of packages. For package 1 demarcation for land acquisition is completed. In this regard the C.O Hailakandi Revenue circle informed that notice is to be issued very shortly to the land owners. At present the Earth work in embankment is going on from the end point for a length of 1300m of the scheme for package-I.
- For package-II, land acquisition is under process. In Package-III where breaches occurred has been closed & other works are being carried out in full swing.
- The breach closing works is completed for the scheme namely “Restoration of dyke flood protection and drainage of Bakrihaor area under Hailakandi Civil sub-Division on the left bank of river Barak including breach closing works”, & other item of works is in progress.
- Land acquisition process is going on for the scheme “Constriction of new embankment from Nutanbazar to Matijuri P.W.D Bridge on left bank of river Katakhal Ph-I”. However earth work has been started from the end point of the scheme. And asked the Circle Officers concerned to resolve all remaining land issues in a time bound manner so as to pave the way for executing of the works.
- All the vulnerable breaches shall be recouped by 15th of this month.
- The D.D.C. directed to expedite the ongoing work & complete the remaining works before the onset of monsoon.
- The DDC directed the EE, to complete all restoration works before the onset of monsoon i.e. by May/2023.

2.PHE:

- The EE, PHE informed that against the target of 169196 nos. of FHTC, 101788 nos. has been completed as on 01-05-2023.
- The DDC directed the EE, PHE to provide water supply connection to Health Sub- Centers & Police outpost/ reserve.
- The DDC directed the EE, PHE to complete preparation of estimates for water supply connection in Police stations and Health Sub- Centers within two days.

3.PWD (Roads) :

- The DDC directed the EE, PWD (R) to speed up completion of all ongoing works.
- The DDC asked EE PWD Roads to submit report against the complaint forwarded by Supdt. of Police, Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Assam regarding anomalies in the construction of a road under PMGSY – III from MRL-10-Chepti Brojapur to Mohanpur Part – VI, within two days.
- The EE PWD Roads informed that proposal has been sent for inclusion of road connecting Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Monacherra under PMGSY. In this regard the DDC requested EE, PWD HDTR to undertake some repairing works from the entry point, so to make the road motor able.
- The DDC requested EE to ensure at least 5% enhancement of physical progress for all schemes undertaken by the department.

(Action:- EE, PWD HDTR, Hailakandi)

4.PWD (Building):

- The DDC directed the EE PWD HDTB expedite progress of work of DTO office. The EE informed that progress is slow due to non receipt of payment. The DDC suggested for communicating with the Govt. for fund.
- The DDC expressed concern over the slow progress of BADP works and directed EE PWD HDTB to complete the ongoing works in war footing manner.
- The Circle Officer, Lala Revenue Circle informed the house that Brick Kiln in Nischintipur Pt-II being constructed without following norms which may cause disaster if timely steps are not taken. In this connection the DDC directed EE,PWD(B) to make a spot visit and submit the detail report.

5.HEALTH:

- The Jt. Director, Health services informed that, 28 nos. of Health Sub Centers don't have functional running water for which proposal has already been submitted to CEO, Zilla Parishad, Hailakandi. The DDC, instructed Jt.DHS to submit the list of 28 nos. of list of PHE department and also instructed PHE to take necessary steps accordingly for providing water supply to their facilities.
- The DDC directed the Jt. DHS, Hailakandi to notify and conduct meeting of District Empanelment Committee (DEC) under Ayushman Bharat. In this regard the Jt. DHS has informed that, no correspondence on this has been received from the State HQ. So, DDC directed Jt. DHS to pursue with State HQ and take necessary steps accordingly.

6.Transport:

- As per monthly report total revenue collected for the month of April/2023 is Rs.51,29,797.00. The Chair asked them to control overloaded vehicles plying in Bilaipur – Dholcherra areas where construction of roads is going on.

(Action: Dist. Transport Officer, Hailakandi)

7.AGRICULTURE:

- The DAO informed that 75,618 nos. of beneficiaries are getting payment under PM-KISAN and no. of AADHAR authenticated 51,380 nos. and e-KYC done is 47,373(90.6%) as on 29-04-2023.
- Under PM-FBY Rabi 2022-23, out of target 2,500 total formed received 1030 and no. of forms uploaded 820.
- The DDC directed to expedite the works of the remaining ADO's office and complete early.
- On a query from the DDC regarding procurement of Paddy the DAO informed that 960.4MT have been procured
- Organic farming is to be encourage on a large scale .

8.DI&CC:

- The GM, DI&CC informed that under PMEGP, 2022-23, Proposals sponsored to Bank 331 nos. and proposals sanctioned by Bank 105 nos., returned by banks 183 nos. and pending 34 nos.
- The DDC directed GM, DI&CC to take the matter with LDM and verify the reasons for rejection and also the cases pending with banks and submit a detail report.
- The DDC also directed the GM, DI&CC to prepare road map marketing of products in consultation with Agriculture department and submit detail report on Areca nut with processing units alongwith other which have produce surplus quantity vis a vis demand .

9.Municipal Board:

- **Lala:** As per monthly report of Lala MB, out of total 1154 no. of beneficiaries under PMAY (Urban), 1039nos. are completed.
- **Hailakandi:** As per monthly report of Hailakandi MB, out of total 2651 no. of beneficiaries under PMAY (Urban), 1719 nos. are completed. Continuous persuasion by Field level staff is required to accelerate the pace of completion.
- The DDC directed the E.Os to lodge FIR against those beneficiaries who have not completed construction of house even after 365 days.

10. Women & Child Development:

- The DDC directed the DSWO to submit status report of land in connection with construction of AWCs. Also asked to submit list of all AWCs for repairing
- He also directed the DSWO to take steps for increasing the number for adoption of AWC

(Action: DSWO, Hailakandi)**11. Fishery:**

- On a query from the DDC, the DFDO informed that the total fish production in the district is 712.22 MT.(April/2023)
- The DDC directed DFDO to be proactive for implementation of schemes and arrange for surprise checking of Formalin fish in the market and etc.
- To take action on “One Village One Pond” on any fishery related schemes

(Action: DFDO, Hailakandi)**12. Excise:**

- The Deputy Supdt. of Excise present in the meeting informed the house that, Rs. 60,89,000/- has been collected upto March, 2023 and for the month of April,2023 revenue collected NIL.
- The DDC directed the Deputy Supdt. to undertake more drives particularly in the tea garden area and Hailakandi Purana Bazar and submit the action taken separately for tea garden area and general area.
- The DDC directed the Deputy Supdt. to take steps for increase in revenue collection.

- The Supdt. taxes, Hailakandi informed the house regarding Revenue collection for the month of April/2023.

- The Executive Engineer, Irrigation was absent in the meeting, no fruitful discussion could be held. The DDC directed to inform the higher authority regarding absence of the EE.

15. ASRLM :

- The DPM of ASRLM, Hailakandi has expressed before the house that during previous Financial Year ASRLM has achieved almost 100% in all parameter except SHG Credit Linkage.
- He also mentioned that 2520 nos. Of SHG was Credit Linked against the target of 3061 which is 81%.
- The DDC directed the DPM to organize SHG Credit Disbursement camps in collaboration with LDM on regular basis to dispose the pending loan proposal of SHGs
- The DPM, ASRLM also highlighted that the issues regarding resuming of PIA under DDU-GKY has not been resolved yet and accordingly matter was informed to the SMD, ASRLM. He also informed that, the PIA called "Power to Empower Pvt. Ltd" has distributed certificate to some trained candidates and their guardians.

16. PWD (NH):

- The EE, PWD (NH) was absent in the meeting and hence no discussion was held.
- The DDC directed to inform the higher authority regarding absence of the EE.

17. Handloom and Textiles:

- The Asstt. Director, Handloom and Textiles informed the house that, under Mudra loan 12 no. of applications received for the year 2023-24 and sent to the bank which is pending with the bank.
- The DDC directed the Asstt. Director to take up the matter with concerned bank or may be taken up in DCC meeting.

(Action: Asstt. Director, Handloom and Textiles, Hailakandi)

18. Education

- The DEEO informed that, the pupils attendance for the month of April in the schools have been monitored and found that schools were functioning properly and the distribution of free text books to the students are going on.
- The DEEO informed that IS, Hailakandi visited 7 no. of schools and BEEEO, Hailakandi, Lala and Katlicherra visited 15 no. of schools, 15 no. of schools and 17 no. of schools respectively.
- The DEEO informed that, all the schools have been electrified.
- The DEEO informed that out of 43 nos. of non-functional girls' toilet, 28 nos. are made functional and 15 nos. are severely damaged. Further, the DEEO informed that out of 56 nos. of non-functional boy's toilet, 32 nos. are made functional and 24 nos. are severely damaged. The DEEO further informed that, repairing of severely damages is not possible from the present infrastructure grant and as such proposal has been sent to the SMO, SSA, Assam for sanction of fund for the purpose

- The DEEO informed that, least of 61 nos. of school have been handed over to PHE , Hailakandi for arrangement of drinking water facility, out of which 25 nos. of schools have already been provided drinking water, boring unsuccessful in 29 nos. of schools, but it will be covered from nearby WSS. Remaining 7 nos. of schools will be included in new scheme.

19. Assam Khadi & Vill. Industries:

- The D.O. informed that, no proposal has been received till 30th April/2023 for the year 2023-24 and all pending loans have been disbursed.
- The DDC informed that he will visit the sites of activities.

(Action: D.O, Assam Khadi & Vill. Industries)

20. Forest :

- The DFO informed the house that, Revenue collection for the month of April/2023 is Rs. 70,210.00.
- The DDC directed the DFO to convene a meeting with all the line departments regarding realization of forest royalty as per 3rd schedule of Mines & Minerals dtd.07.10.2021, which was published in The Assam Gazette, Extraordinary, October 11, 2021.

- On a query from the DDC, the Dist. A.H.& Vety. Officer informed that, there is sufficient stock of medicines and feeds for the Livestock in view of ensuing rainy season and high lands for shelter of animals have been identified in the event of flood.

(Action: A.H. & Vety. Officer, Hailakandi)

23. Soil Conservation:

- The DDC directed the D.O. to take up schemes of water harvesting in consultation with Agriculture and other concerned departments and bring new guidelines, if any, for Rain water harvesting in school where there are readymade storage provision are lying.

(Action: D.O., Soil Conservation, Hailakandi)

24. Sericulture:

- The Asstt. Director, Sericulture informed that, for SOM plantation 2 (two) nos. of convergence has already been taken up at Algapur and South Hailakandi Dev. Block.
- The Asstt. Director, Sericulture also informed that, to make Govt. land at Madaripur and Karicherra Farm encroachment free, action has been initiated by the C.O. Katlicherra and Lala Rev. Circle.

(Action: Asstt. Director, Sericulture, Hailakandi)

At the end, the District Development Commissioner directed all works Deptt. to expedite the progress of works as rainy season is approaching.
