

Minutes of the District Development Committee (DDC) Meeting for the month of April, 2022 held on 06-04-2022 at 11.00 A.M. in the Conference Hall of DC's Office, Hailakandi.

Members Present : As per Annexure – 'A'.

The meeting was presided over by District Development Commissioner, Hailakandi. At the outset, he welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Initiating the discussion the DDC reviewed the progress of AAGY (Assam Adarsha Gram Yojana) & PMAGY (Pradhan Mantri Adarsha Gram Yojana). The BDOs who are the executing agencies of the scheme informed the house, about the progress of works under AAGY. The DDC asked all BDO's concerned to complete works before 10th April/2022 in view of the visit of officials from Dispur for inspection of the AAGY scheme in the district shortly.

In this regard, he requested all heads of departments of the district to take up schemes in the 16 nos of selected villages (6 nos under AAGY and 10 nos under PMAGY) on priority basis and to work in a coordinated manner to make villages as 'Adarsha Gram' (Model Village) in true sense of the term . DDC, requested to all BDOs to Coordinate with the Department in this regard.
